1. PERSONAL DATA ADMINISTRATOR

2. LEGAL BASIS FOR PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

We process your personal data only if the processing is necessary for:

- a. contract fulfillment between you as a Customer and the Administrator or for the implementation of measures by the Administrator before concluding such a contract within the meaning of Article 6, paragraph 1, letter b) Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (hereinafter referred to as the "Regulation"),
- b. compliance with the legal obligations applicable to the Administrator within the meaning of Article 6 (1) (a); c) Regulations, namely in particular the fulfillment of obligations imposed on the Administrator by generally binding legal regulations, in particular Act No. 235/2004 Coll., on value added tax, as amended, Act No. 586/1992 Coll., on income taxes, as amended, by Act No. 563/1991 Coll., on Accounting, as amended, by Act No. 89/2012 Coll., Civil Code, as amended, and Act No. 634/1992 Coll., on consumer protection, as amended,
- c. the purposes of the legitimate interests of the Administrator within the meaning of Article 6, paragraph 1, letter f) Regulation.

3. PERSONAL DATA CATEGORIES PROCESSED BY ADMINISTRATOR

The administrator processes your following personal data:

- a. Identification and address data: name, surname, academic degree, company name, date of birth, company identification number (CIN), tax identification



- number, address of permanent residence, registered office address, delivery or other contact address,
- b. Electronic contact details: telephone number, e-mail address, fax,
 - c. Bank details: bank account number, IBAN, BIC, SWIFT, credit card details.

4. PURPOSE OF PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

The purpose of processing your personal data is to fulfill the contract concluded between the Administrator and you as a Customer, including delivery of goods and resolution of rights from liability for defects or quality guarantees, or implementation of measures by the Administrator before concluding such a contract, further fulfillment of related legal obligations by the Administrator, legitimate interests of the Administrator also the exercise and defense of the legal rights of the Administrator and the internal administrative purposes of the Administrator.

5. PERSONAL DATA SOURCES

We collect your personal data:

- a. From you, especially in the context of negotiations on concluding a contract or communication with you,
- b. From public sources, in particular from the Commercial Register, the Trade Register, the Federal Register, the Foundation Register, the Register of Institutes, the Register of Trust Funds, the Register of Economic Entities and the Insolvency Register.

6. THE TIME OF PERSONAL DATA STORAGE

Your personal data will be processed for the duration of the rights and obligations under the contract (including the duration of warranty, complaint and other periods relating to the contract, where the parties may exercise the rights and obligations under the contract), for the limitation period of any claim under the contract and furthermore, for the time necessary for the purposes of archiving in accordance with the relevant generally binding legal regulations, but no longer than for the period specified in the generally binding legal regulations.

7. OTHER RECIPIENTS OF PERSONAL DATA

Recipients of your personal data may be forwarding companies and other persons involved in the delivery of goods or payment under a contract concluded between



the Administrator and the Customer and persons providing the Administrator with technical services related to website operation and order form, including software operation and data storage or providers of tax and accounting advice.

The Administrator may provide your personal data to other entities if the provision of such data to the Administrator is required by law, if this is necessary to fulfill the obligations arising from the law or if it is necessary to protect the legitimate interests of the Administrator and protect its rights, e.g. insurance companies, legal service providers, courts, state administration bodies, including bailiffs, bodies active in criminal, misdemeanor or administrative proceedings, tax administrators, the scope of personal data provided is limited to the data necessary for the successful enforcement of the claim.

The Administrator does not intend to transfer your personal data to a third country (outside the EU) or to an international organization.

8. DATA SUBJECT RIGHTS

Under the conditions set out in the Regulation, you have the following rights:

- a. the right to request from the Administrator access to your personal data and to obtain a copy of your personal data processed by the Administrator,
- b. the right to correct your personal data if you find that the Administrator processes incorrect or inaccurate personal data about you,
- c. the right to delete your personal data if the data is not necessary for the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed, you raise objections to processing based on legitimate interest, if there are no overriding legitimate reasons for the Processing Administrator, your personal data is processed unlawfully, your personal data must be deleted in order to fulfill a legal obligation laid down in the law of the European Union or the Czech Republic or your personal data has been collected in connection with the offer of information company,
- d. the right to restrict the processing of your personal data, if the processed personal data are inaccurate, the processing is illegal, the processed personal data are not necessary for the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed or raise objections to the processing,
- e. the right to the transferability of your personal data, ie if the Administrator processes your personal data on the basis of your consent or for the purposes of fulfilling the contract and at the same time you automatically have the right to obtain your personal data and the right to transfer this data to another administrator, in a structured, in a commonly used and machine-readable

format, provided that this right must not adversely affect the rights and freedoms of others,

- f. if you believe that the processing of your personal data has violated or is infringing the Regulation, you have, inter alia, the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, which is the Personal Data Protection Authority or another competent supervisory authority of a Member State of the European Union, which is responsible for supervising compliance with the obligations laid down by the GDPR (in particular, the supervisory authority in the Member State of your habitual residence, place of employment or the place where the alleged infringement took place).

You also have the right to object to the processing of your personal data if your personal data is processed for the purpose of performing a task performed in the public interest or in the exercise of public power, for the legitimate interest of the Administrator or a third party or for direct marketing purposes, including profiling.

The Administrator does not have an automated decision-making, ie decision-making based solely on automated processing (including profiling), which would have legal effects for you or otherwise significantly affect you.

You are not obliged to provide personal data. The provision of your personal data is a necessary requirement for the conclusion and performance of the contract and without the provision of your personal data, it is not possible to conclude the contract or fulfill it by the Administrator.
